

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered by and between:

UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES, the National University, created by virtue of Act No. 1870, as amended and strengthened by Republic Act No. 9500, otherwise known as "The University of the Philippines Charter of 2008" through its constituent university at Diliman, with official address at Quezon Hall, U.P. Campus, Diliman, Quezon City, 1101, Philippines, represented herein by its Chancellor, EDGARDO CARLO L. VISTAN II hereinafter referred to as "UPD"

AND

SILLIMAN UNIVERSITY, a private, non-stock, non-profit institution of higher learning, founded in 1901 by the Board of Foreign Missions of the Presbyterian Church in the U.S.A., and now affiliated with the United Church of Christ in the Philippines, located in Dumaguete City, Philippines, duly existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, represented in this act by its President, BETTY CERNOL- MCCANN, Ph.D., hereinafter referred to as "SU"

WITNESSETH: THAT

WHEREAS, in line with their respective academic and educational programs, the parties to this instrument have recognized the benefits of collaboration and exchange programs;

WHEREAS, the parties to this instrument aim to develop collaborative programs in areas of mutual interest:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above general statements and the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties to this instrument hereby agree and bind themselves as follows:

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to develop academic 1. and educational exchange and to promote mutual understanding between Silliman University (SU) and the University of the Philippines - Diliman (UPD);

- 2. Both Universities agree to develop the following activities in academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity;
 - a. Exchange of faculty, researchers and other research and administrative staff;
 - b. Exchange of students;
 - c. Collaborative research projects;
 - d. Lectures and symposia;
 - e. Exchange of academic information and materials
 - f. Other forms of academic cooperation
- 3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MOU will be separately negotiated and agreed upon between the schools, colleges, departments or institutes which carry out the specific projects. This shall be subject of a separate written agreement between the two Universities. Both Universities agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the rules, regulations, policies, and procedures of both Universities after full consultation and approval from the other party.
- 4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the cooperative activities stated in clause 2 may be restricted depending upon the availability of resources and funds at the Universities concerned.
- 5. Both Universities agree that, in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights or other intellectual property rights, a further agreement must be negotiated in each case in accordance with the policies of the two parties on intellectual property. Both UPD and SU shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to the ownership and other property interests that may arise.
- 6. The parties understand that this MOU is preliminary in nature. The parties acknowledge that they are not legally obligated to bind themselves to enter into any further agreements upon execution of this MOU.
- 7. This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both Universities.
- 8. The parties represent that they have the requisite authority and capacity to enter this MOU and to bind the institutions represented to perform their obligations and undertakings stipulated herein.

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- 9. In the event of an unforeseen incident during collaborative activities, both Universities agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution. As far as practicable, these solutions shall be incorporated into the specific agreements mentioned in clause 3.
- 10. This MOU is valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of signature by the representatives of both Universities. This MOU may be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both Universities. Unless there is formal communication between the parties to terminate the MOU, it shall be assumed that there is intent to renew the MOU for the same period.
- 11. This MOU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by the Universities, upon prior notice to the other party in writing, at least six months before the termination date.
- 12. Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of this MOU, the Universities shall endeavor to exercise their best efforts to negotiate the differences.
- 13. Both UPD and SU mutually agree to process personal information and sensitive personal information in conformity with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012) and all other applicable laws and regulations.

Both Universities shall ensure that the appropriate organization, physical, and technical measures are in place to maintain the confidentiality, integrity, and security of personal information and sensitive personal information that may come to its knowledge or possession by reason of any provision of this MOU and that its employees, agents, representatives, or any person acting under its authority shall hold said information under strict confidentiality at all times.
